As a sign of their commitment to early childhood, these cities have adopted the **#naticonlacultura Cultural Passport**, created by the **Fondazione Medicina a Misura di Donna**, which allows families free access to over 45 Family and Kids Friendly museums in the **Abbonamento Musei** network during their children's first year of life. The Passport is issued by healthcare facilities at birth or sent by the participating city administrations and can also be downloaded for all newborns from the website [naticonlacultura.it](https://naticonlacultura.it).

The local health board **ASL TO4** with the Birth Centers of the Hospitals of Ciriè, Chivasso, and Ivrea, attending since the first edition, and the hospital companies of the City of Turin and the metropolitan area: The **AOU Città della Salute e della Scienza** with the **Sant'Anna Hospital**, **ASL Città di Torino** with the family and pediatric health centers (Consultori familiari e pediatrici) and the Maria Vittoria and Martini Hospitals, **AO Ordine Mauriziano di Torino**, **ASL TO3** with the Rivoli and Pinerolo Hospitals and the territorial health centers (Consultori territoriali), **ASL TO5**.
